

RC Flight School Optimized RealFlight 9 Plane & TX Settings - Spektrum Transmitter & wireless Dongle

STEP 1 Create a New Folder on your Desktop to store downloaded files. Click on the desired RC Flight School (RCFS) aircraft and transmitter (TX) model memories and Save them to the New Folder.

RCFS TX model memories are .SPM files for DX series radios, .NSPM for NX, or .iSPM for iX
.SPM files should load into all three DX, NX, and iX series radios.

RCFS AV (Aircraft Variants) are .RFX files and will eventually be located in: Documents > RealFlight 9 > RFX

- **STEP 2** Open the Folder and Save the desired RealFlight (RF) TX models to a 32 GB or less blank SD card. Insert the SD card into your TX and Import the "RF xxxxx by RCFS" models individually -or- Import All Models.
- **STEP 3** Select a new blank model in the TX with everything set to defaults. There is no need to name it or do anything else with it since this model memory will only be used to Calibrate the TX in RealFlight.

STEP 4 Run RealFlight > FLY. Click on Simulation (upper left toolbar) > Select Controller > Receiver Profile > select Spektrum > then click Edit.
☐ Uncheck any checked Reverse boxes.
☐ Click on the wide Input buttons for Channels 1, 2, 3, and 4 to open the Input Detection window and move the associated control input to assign the correct control movement to each channel.
☐ Uncheck all the Input boxes along the far right side of the Edit window except 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, and 8. In other word 1-through-8 except for 5
 □ Click on the Channel 6 Input button and toggle switch D to assign it for flap control. □ Click on the Channel 7 Input button and toggle switch A for retracts. □ Click on the Channel 8 Input button and toggle switch B for SAFE - Intermediate - Experienced Modes.
\square Uncheck Enable Software Radio Mixes and Enable Software Radio Dual Rates and Expo boxes.
Close and Save. Name the Profile. Example: Spektrum RCFS Planes (These steps only have to be done once, whether flying RCFS or other aircraft, as long as you continue to use the Spektrum Receiver Profile you created)

- **STEP 5** Calibrate the Transmitter/Controller NOTICE! When calibrating the transmitter, ensure the trims are neutral and all TX settings (Model Type, Travel, D/R, Mixing, etc.) are set to defaults.
- **STEP 6** Select the desired RCFS model variant in your TX and Bind it to the USB wireless Dongle plugged into your computer. (Note: A USB extension cord will make Binding and rebinding the Dongle more convenient.)
- **STEP 7** In RealFlight, click on Simulation > Import > RealFlight Archive > Look in: Locate and Open the file where you saved all the RCFS aircraft > check All > Open to Save/Import them.
- **STEP 8** Click on Aircraft to bring down the menu > Select Aircraft > open Custom Aircraft > Select the aircraft that matches the model selected in your TX and fly.

As in the real world, you'll need to trim and fine tune rates to match the airplane behavior exactly to your preferences.

Whenever you need to reverse a servo, do so in the transmitter.

When applicable, Dual Rates are controlled by switch **C**. It is recommended that you do not change this due to the interaction of switch **C** with other functions.

When applicable, switch **B** selects SAFE = self correcting with bank and pitch angle limits — Intermediate = conventional control but with bank and pitch angle limits — Experienced = conventional control with no attitude limits. Note that Intermediate Mode is sometimes erratic and may or may not prove usable.

The following aircraft are listed in order of degree of difficulty and/or performance...



RCFS Variant: <u>AeroScout by RCFS</u>
TX Model: <u>RF AeroScout by RCFS</u>

Switch B Modes: Pos 0 = SAFE - Pos 1 = Intermediate - Pos 2 = Experienced

Note that in SAFE Mode throttle affects altitude: High throttle = climb / mid throttle = level / low throttle = descent

Switch B Modes: Pos 0 = SAFE - Pos 1 = Intermediate - Pos 2 = Experienced

Switch D Flaps

** "Accelerating" Snaps and Spins, i.e., reducing or using less elevator during snaps and spins, cuts down on heading deviations, speed loss, and produces a better looking maneuver.

Switch B Modes: Pos 2 = Experienced - Pos 1 = Intermediate - Pos 0 = SAFE

Switch B Modes: Pos 2 = Experienced/Precision - Pos 1 = Mid Rates - Pos 0 = SAFE

Switch C Rates: Pos 2 Precision - Pos 1 = **Snap or Spin - Pos 0 = High Hammerhead

** "Accelerating" snaps, i.e., reducing or lessening elevator during the snap produces a better overall maneuver.

Switch C Rates: Pos 2 = Precision (slow speed rolling circle trainer©) - Pos 1 = 3D - Pos 0 = 100%

Switch C Modes: Pos 2 = Precision - Pos 1 = Mid - Pos 0 = SAFE (SAFE ailerons are slightly erratic⊗)

Switch C Rates: Pos 2 = Precision - Pos 1 = Mid - Pos 0 = High - Target speed = \(\frac{1}{2} - \frac{3}{4} \) throttle

Note: It is necessary to install the original RealFlight Revo, OREKA, and Oxai Pinnacle pattern planes in order for the RC Flight School variants of them to become available.

(Note: Switch C Pos 1 spoken "Spin Rates" was the closest to "snap rates" available in the sound list)

Switch C Rates: Pos 2 = Precision - Pos 1 = Snap/Spin - Pos 0 = 100% Hammerhead / FAI

Switch C Rates: Pos 2 Precision - Pos 1 = **Snap roll. Pos 0 = Spin or Hammerhead / FAI ** "Accelerating" snap rolls, i.e., inputting less elevator produces a better overall maneuver.

Switch C Rates: Pos 2 = Precision IMAC - Pos 1 = **Snap/Spin - Pos 0 = Hammerhead

** "Accelerating" snaps and spins produces a better overall maneuver.

Switch C Rates: Pos 2 = Precision - Pos 1 = 3D - Pos 0 = High

Switch B Modes: Pos 2 = Precision - Pos 1 = Mid - Pos 0 = SAFE (target speed in SAFE = ½ - ¾ throttle)

Switch B Modes: Pos 2 = Precision - Pos 1 = Intermediate - Pos 2 = SAFE (target speed in SAFE = $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ throttle)

Switch B Modes: Pos 0 = Normal - Pos 1 = Stunt 1 Low Rates - Pos 2 = Stunt 2 Mid Rates

Switch B Modes: Pos 0 = Normal - Pos 1 = Stunt 1 Low Rates - Pos 2 = Stunt 2 Mid Rates (Note: Advance throt very slowly during Initial liftoff. Liftoff and landing will normal after that.)

Switch B Modes: Pos 0 = Stabilize - Pos 1 = Altitude hold - Pos 2 = Loiter

Additional Notes:

If you encounter latency issues displaying RealFlight on a larger second monitor/screen, the solution is to Right click on your desktop > click on Display settings > scroll down to Multiple Displays > open and select: **Show only on 2**

If having problems with the plane becoming too small, press the " \mathbf{Z} " key to get to Autozoom View setting. Press + or – to zoom in or out. Note that Chase or Onboard Views only work in 3D fields.

Windsock angle/wind equivalent: $15^{\circ} = 5$ mph, $30^{\circ} = 10$ mph, $45^{\circ} = 15$ mph, horizontal windsock = 30+ mph! Home key controls wind direction. Pg Up - Pg Dn controls wind speed. Press Delete to remove turbulence.

To turn off smoke/exhaust: View > Scenery > uncheck Particles

Due to varied Travel, Dual Rate, and mix settings, the Radio Gadget in RealFlight does not reflect the actual control inputs applied, and therefore shouldn't be interpreted as offering precise feedback on how to fly each maneuver.

Replacing Spacebar Reset with Reset Button on 8+ channel Spektrum TX...

TX: System Setup > Channel Assign > Aux 3: select "I" (Bind Button) = Gear: A, Aux 1: D, Aux 2: B, Aux 3: I

Sim: Simulation > Select Controller > Edit > scroll down to Reset and click on the Input button > push the Bind button to select it. (Aux 3 will have to be set to "I" on each sim model in your TX that you want to Reset with the Bind button.)

It may, or may not, be necessary to deactivate Rewind in the Sim: Simulation > Settings > Graphics > Enable Rewind = No

NOTICE: In order to capitalize on RCFS sim models, you must 1. Initially calibrate the Controller using a new model memory set to defaults. 2. Match the correct TX model memory to the RealFlight model. 3. Trim the model for straight and level upright flight in all 3 axes.
